

HOW TO BOOK


The Greenwood Learning Alliance platform can be accessed via the web address: www.greenwoodlearningalliance.org

HOW TO LOG IN

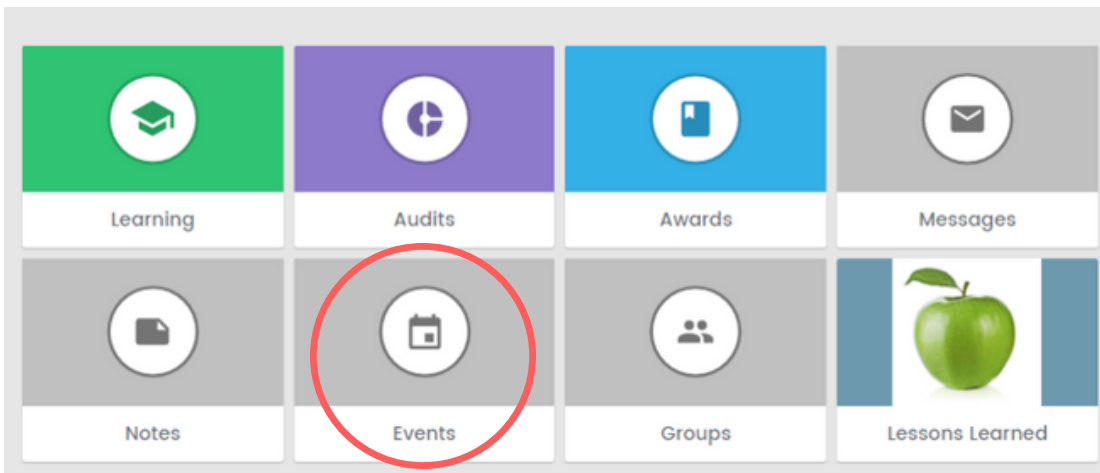
Click on the login link and enter your email address and your Virtual College password. Click on the 'Log In' button and you will be logged straight into the platform.



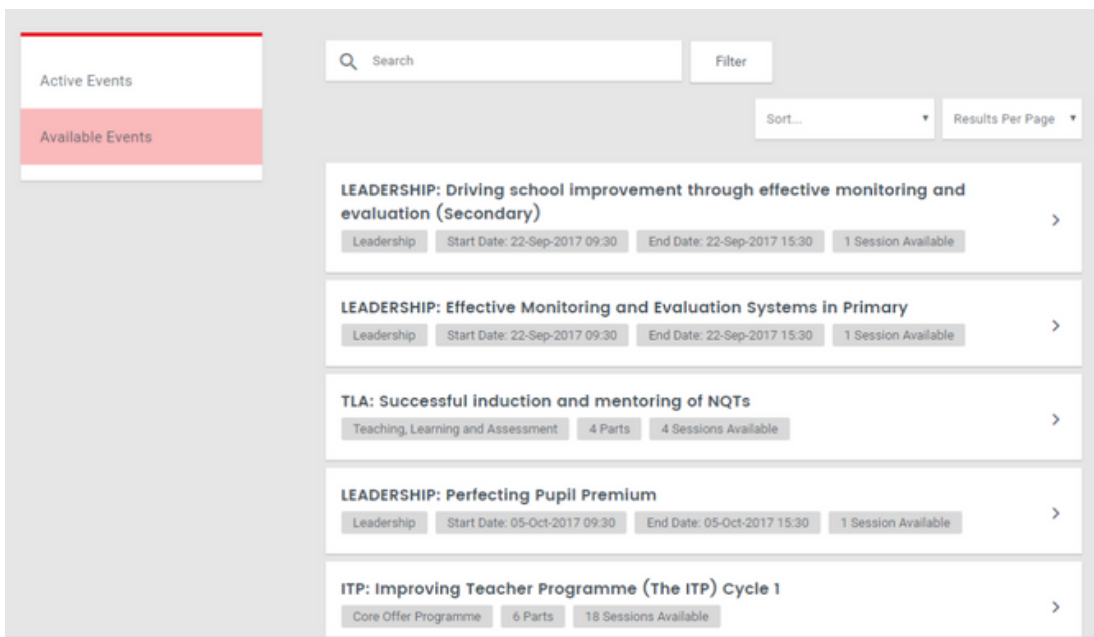
Please note that if you have forgotten your password you can click on the 'Forgotten your password' link below the 'Log In' button. You will then be asked to enter your email address, tick 'I'm not a robot', complete the visual quiz and then click on the 'Request Password Reset' button. An email will then be sent through to you, which will contain a link to re-set your password.

HOW TO BOOK ON TO A TRAINING COURSE or PROGRAMME (Events)

1. Click on the Events tile from your Learner Dashboard.



2. Select 'Available Events' and a list of all the events which are available for you to book on to will appear.



3. Click on the arrow to the far right hand side of the event title in order to view the event. You will be able to see the detail for the event and either book if it is an open course, request attendance or add yourself to a course waiting list.
